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Opening

Atlanta Nepali School

Sagun Shrestha gave a background and the status on the school. Gobinda Shrestha, Suman Silwal, and Manoj Silwal provided further information and participated in the discussion. The group agreed that the school should be opened soon. It is desirable that we make Atlanta School a model that other city and states could follow. Sagun Shrestha said that he will work with the NASeA Nepali School Committee and will take on the recommended actions quickly.

Business Card for NASeA Executive Committee Members

Sanjeeb Sapkota suggested that NASeA executive members should have a business card that will help in promoting the organization and networking. Earlier he had shared a template. Suman Silwal suggested that such card is required only for the president as he is the person who represents the organization. Dhana Timilsina said that other members of the executive committee too should have the card as they too would promote the organization. It was discussed and agreed on that it is better to have a generic card with the names of all the officials at the back. Sagun Shrestha volunteered to work on the design and share among members.

Certificate for the elected officials

Dhana Timilsina and Sanjeeb Sapkota suggested a certificate for all the elected officials. Suman asked the value of certificate. Dhana Timilsina and Gobinda Shrestha said it is for standardization, professionalism, and motivation among officials. Raja Ghale said motivation is highly needed for the team's work.
