 - 12 students passed SLC.
 - Mr. Dongol is working with Mr. Hari Dhungana towards getting them financial assistantship.
- c. Kakani School Update /Ram Dongol
 - Mr. Dongol is working with Dr. Prakash Malla towards getting them financial assistantship.
- d. NC University Nepali Language Program Funding (\$500) /Dr. Narayan Rajbhandari
 - Got some materials from Nepal
 - Different fundraising activities will be done to collect money.
- e. Transfer of Technology / Samir Upadhyay

- Mr. Samir Upadhyay visited Laxmi school, 2 computers were handed to them.
- Mr. Upadhyay will take a lead on this project.
